

Homework

In EYFS we will sometimes send home a creative homework—this will be on paper and also on Tapestry. We encourage you to help your child with their homework but not do it for them, we would rather know they struggled than think they got it all right. I will inform you on Tapestry what the homework is and where you can find it. The children will also get a weekly phonics home learning sheet for you to help to reinforce what we have been learning in school.

PE

Foundation Stage have PE on a Friday, please ensure your child comes to school in their full PE kit on this day. During the colder months children will need to wear the winter PE kit. If your child struggles to tie laces, trainers with velcro are preferred. If they are laces, please ensure they are double knotted. Please ensure all clothing and personal belongings are labelled with your child's name.

Reading Book

Books need to be in school on a Monday and will be returned on a Wednesday. Please enjoy spending some time with your child each night reading their book with them and write a brief record of what they have read in their reading record book (we will only change the books once their reading record has been signed). This helps us to see how well they are doing with their reading at home and regular reading helps them to make more progress.

Snacks

A healthy snack is provided every morning for your child at a cost of £36.00 for the school year which is paid via Parentpay. Children are also provided with a piece of fruit in the afternoon. Please send a water bottle into school with your child (no juice). Milk is provided to children each morning at a cost of £6.00 per school year. This is payable via Parentpay. Please inform the school office if you do not wish your child to have milk.
