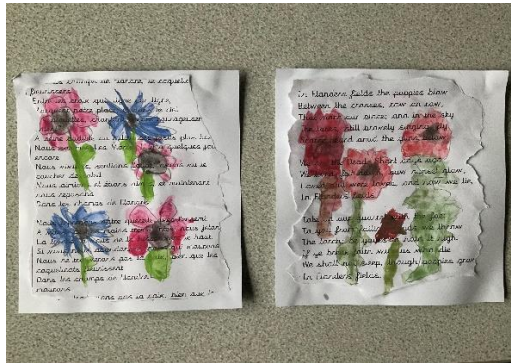

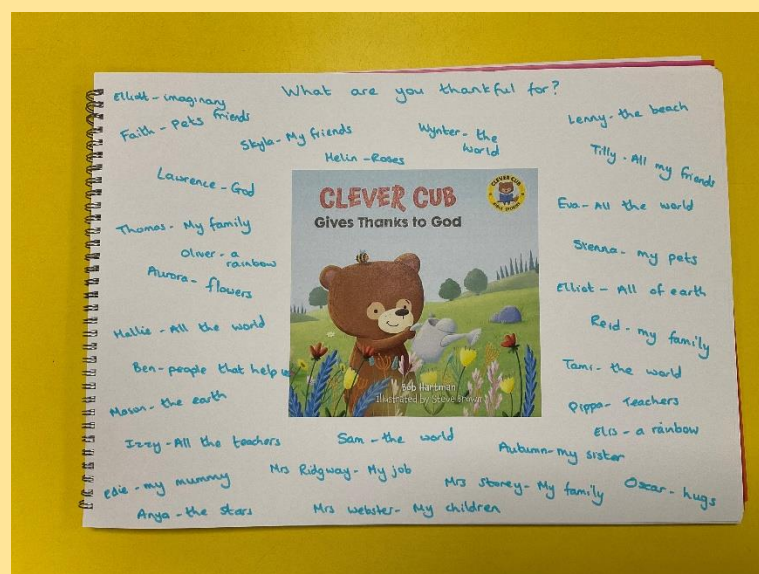
- Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> November at 9 am and 2.45pm - Year 2 Reading for SATS meeting for Parents (School Hall)
