



**FACT**: The more time your child spends in school, the better your child's attainment.

#### Guidelines for any child who has an infectious disease and must remain off school

Chicken Pox	At least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until the blisters have all crusted over	
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode	
Cold and Flu-like symptoms including Covid 19	They no longer have a temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance for COVID 19 which is currently 3 days	
Impetigo	Their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they have started on antibiotics	
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared	
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started	
Scabies	They've had their first treatment	
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they start taking antibiotics	
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they start taking antibiotics
