We have 2 events planned for this term:


Thursday 15th December 5 pm – 7 pm Christmas Movie Night -The Polar Express

Safeguarding Updates

Dark Nights

When the nights start to draw in, this concerns all parents/carers have about keeping children safe during the darker nights. Here are some hints and tips for driving and walking in the dark

- **Driving in the dark** is different from daytime driving. You are less aware of pedestrians and have to be more alert to things going on around the car. For this reason, children must understand the importance of behaving responsibly when sitting in their cars as passengers.
- Walking in the dark Children need to be aware that they need to be visible to other road users. Experiment with the children to see how many things they see in the dark, this helps them to learn how they might not always be visible to road users. Tips include reflective visibility on coats/jackets. Children must not assume they can be seen if streetlights are on and must be careful when running ahead as drivers are not able to see them. Children must be supported when crossing any roads.
