School Council "Penny Sabotage 20 Day Challenge" fundraising for "EduKid"

Beginning 1st December

The rules are simple. Each class will have a collection box. The aim is for classes to compete against each other to collect the most "coppers" as you can – 1p and 2ps.

Your class adds pennies to your box, but here's the twist ... you can sabotage the other classes' attempts by adding silver or gold coins to their box (boxes will be located on the Key stage 2 corridor on entry to school and Key stage 1 corridor).

At the end of the **Penny Challenge**, teachers will add up how many **pennies** are in each box, and then subtract the number of silver and gold coins in the same jar. The class with the highest total points after the silver and gold coins have been subtracted is deemed the winner and will win a prize for their class. All money raised will go towards "Edukid".




'Living life in its fullness' at Nutgrove
