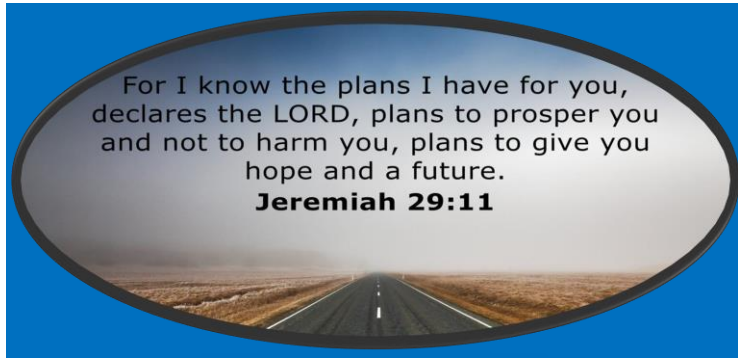

Reminder for the New School Year
